Launched in 2018, Muthoot Aashiyana Project was put forward by Muthoot Finance after the devastating floods in Kerala in the same year which witnessed thousands of families losing their homes. Muthoot Finance has allocated a cumulative spend of Rs. 20 cr towards the CSR initiative. The construction was planned in the worst-hit areas by the floods including Paravoor, Chengannur, Alwaye, Thiruvalla, Aranmula, Kozhencherry, Kuttanad, Kumarakom, Thodupuzha, Malappuram, Chellanam, Trichur and Idukki. These houses are rebuilt in the exact location where the beneficiaries had their homes pre-floods to retain their emotional connect. The company has managed to surpass the set number of 200 houses.

Under the patronage of Project Aashiyana, Muthoot Finance in association with Habitat for Humanity India & Village Sarpanch has built and handed over 20 houses for the financially declining underprivileged families in Rewari, Haryana. All the 20 families belong to financially weaker segments of the society in which 13 of the beneficiaries were widows. The houses are built as per the government-approved, highest engineering standards consisting of a living room, two bedrooms, kitchen, bathroom and a sanitation unit. The official inauguration and key handover ceremony was performed by Dr. Mrs. Sara George Muthoot - Director, St. George Education Society, Shri. What is Project Aashiyana?

Launched in 2018, Muthoot Aashiyana is one of the flagship CSR initiatives of Muthoot Finance. For the last 4 years, we have been constructing 202 homes for people

who lost their shelters in the devastating floods of Kerala. Aashiyana flood resilient homes are been built in various locations of Kerala - Paravoor, Aluva, Chengannor, Aranmula, Thiuvalla, Kozhancherry, Kuttanad, Kumarakom, Thodupuzha, Malappuram, Chellanam, Thrissur, and Idukki. Aashiyana homes intend to create long-term sustainable habitats for communities and improve their quality of living. It was after considering the project impact and need assessment that the company had decided to instigate the project in Rewari, Haryana as well.

Higher Education Scholarship Distribution

Muthoot M George Foundation, the CSR arm of Muthoot Finance Itd, has facilitated grants to deserving students with Professional Scholarships for the Year 2021-22 in Bangalore. The project is carried out as a part of Muthoot Finance's CSR Initiative, with the aim of promoting education and rewarding deserving students who wish to pursue their professional education.

Initially, the project started in Kerala in 2017 and extended it to Delhi, Maharashtra, Telangana, and Karnataka in 2021. Around 220 students have benefited from this effort, and we've given them 1.9 crores as scholarships. The scholarship is awarded to students of three professional courses –Medicine, Engineering and Nursing.





The award is available to students until they complete their studies. We offered Rs. 200,000 to MBBS students and Rs. 100,000 to B.Tech. & B.Sc. nursing students when we first launched the scheme in 2017. The scholarship amount increased to Rs. 2, 40,000 for MBBS and Rs. 1, 20,000 for B. Tech. and B. Sc. Nursing starting with the 2021 batch. The students who are receiving the scholarship now.

A bold new initiative - Breaking the taboos around mensturation.

Muthoot Finance in Association with Shri. Hibi Eden MP, IMA Kochi Chapter and District Administration has successfully conducted a 2 month long menstrual health campaign in Kochi, Kerala - titled the "Cup of Life" where in which we spread awareness on menstrual health through grass root level awareness and training programs and finally delivered 1 Lakh menstrual cups free to the womanhood of Kochi.

What is the objective of the Cup of Life campaign?



- Introduce an environment friendly and economically viable menstrual hygiene product called the Menstrual cup.
- Create awareness about the use of Menstrual cups against the normal sanitary pads.
- Provide menstrual cups to 1,00,000 beneficiaries.
- Provide proper awareness and training to the woman.
- To expedite knowledge of good quality menstrual cups available in the market.
- Normalize conversations about menstruation among all sexes.
- Abolish social stigma and taboos surrounding virginity and menstruation.
- Comprehensive training sessions by doctors, awareness campaigns, social experiments, and more through which we aim to cultivate inquisitiveness.

Why Menstrual Cups?

Surveys have estimated that there are around 17 lakhs women residing in Kochi across various age groups. Imagine the cost of sanitary pads incurred for them during a typical menstrual cycle. By replacing the sanitary pads with menstrual cups, they can receive a great cost advantage. Menstrual cups are also a sustainable alternative in terms of environmental impact as well. Compared to sanitary napkins, these menstrual cups are far more healthier for women as well.

Cup of Life - Background of the project

- The revolutionary event was initially announced on the International Women's Day
- It is for the first time that a program of its stature and scale is happening in India.
- •The pilot program Avalkayi was conducted in Kumbalangi Grama Panchayat where the Government Authorities have conducted training programs for women across 17 wards. As part of Sansad Adarsh Yojana.
- The authorities had later distributed menstrual cups to women and as a result, Kumbalangi became the First Sanitary Napkin Free Panchayat.
- After the success of the pilot program at Kumbalangi, the district administration and MP was looking for sponsors for scaling up this campaign in Ernakulam. Muthoot Finance decided to take up the entire program since it was falling under the patronage of EHE Environment, Health and Education which are the core areas of operation for the company.
- The project was scientifically verified by the expertise of IMA Kochi chapter and further backed by District Administration.
- •2 Month long workshops, celebrity collaborations, contentful discussions, women entrepreneurs etc were part of this humongous program.
- •The menstrual cups distributed under the program adhere to high quality platinum used silicon cups to ensure supreme quality. Liquid grade silicon 212 Toxic Test Certified.



Cup of Life - Highlights

- The cups, which were collected by the nodal officers and representatives of all 126 venues from the counters set up at the Rajiv Gandhi Indoor Stadium on August 30. Free distribution to those who had pre-registered was completed on August 31, 5 pm.
- Registration process was conducted through local bodies, colleges, voluntary organizations and major institutions of Ernakulam Parliamentary Constituency. The project was implemented with the participation of Ernakulam district administration and IMA Kochi.
- Two months long awareness campaigns and technical sessions were organized as part of the project. Under the leadership of IMA Kochi, about a thousand volunteers were trained on menstrual hygiene and the use of menstrual cups. More than 40 doctors worked for the success of the project. Doctors appointed by IMA conducted scientific studies on menstrual cups and selected the cups. The doctors of IMA Kochi branch also took up the task of training the trainers.
- Pain simulators for men to experience menstrual pain were displayed at various centers. Hundreds of people including college students and celebrities have experienced menstrual cramps through the simulator.
- A theme music sung and acted by young singer Arya Dayal was also prepared for the event. Movie star Jayasuriya released the logo of the project. An advertisement film starring actress Aishwarya Lakshmi was



also released to promote the project.

- A campaign program was also organized in which Ramesh Pisharati and Hibi Eden participated. An open discussion on the topic of menstruation and sixty was held in Kochi Metro train from Aluva to Pettah. Discussions were also organized in various colleges.
- The Cup of Life has promoted the messages of nature conservation, financial gain, 3000 independent days, women empowerment, gender equality and awareness against social taboos.
- The official announcement about getting a place in the Guinness Book was made at a special stage prepared at the Lulu Mall Atrium. R&D Centre, MITS

Supply of Essential Equipments for the Innovative R&D Projects in CIDRIE



CIDRIE, the Center for Industrial Consultancy, Interdisciplinary Research, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, is involved with activities under four heads, namely: 1) Industrial collaborations and Consultancy, 2) Interdisciplinary Research 3) Innovation and 4) Entrepreneurship.

- Industrial Collaborations and Consultancy: Collaboration has been established with Muthoot Finance Group, Stanmore Tea and Mudy's Tea Estates. An MOU with BPCL is work in progress.
- Interdisciplinary Research: A Tinkering Laboratory equipped with all basic facilities (electronic components, tools, 3D printer, power supplies and various other consumables) enabling rapid prototyping of new ideas has been established to foster scientific spirit in students and faculty. This facility has gained good acceptance among the student community at MITS. Students voluntarily work in the Lab after college hours and during holidays on several projects with relevance to society, environment, health care etc.
- Innovation: On the Innovation front, provisional patent applications have been filed for two products and two more products are in the filing process. Students and staff have been encouraged to view the work that they are doing in terms of IP potential and to undertake copyright and patenting of processes and products to protect their IP.
- Entrepreneurship: The center is trying to motivate all stakeholders to actively consider and pursue entrepreneurship opportunities. MITS is also facilitating the establishment of startups through the incubation center (BHub) within the campus. Currently one faculty startup has been provided space in BHub while there are a few others under discussion.

Some of the projects that the center is helping to develop are:

- Design and development of a Rubber Tapping machine for deskilling rubber tapping and also to reduce fatigue in workers in this industry.
- Design and development of a Tea Harvesting machine to reduce fatigue in manual tea harvesters thereby promoting their wellbeing.
- Design and development of reusable gold loan packets thereby reducing plastic waste generation considerably.
- Design and development of electric scooter for the geriatric population as well as people with mobility problems. This scooter is an electric vehicle which can be used both indoors as well as outdoors.
- Design and development of a petrol-electric hybrid two wheeler (scooter) which is environment friendly and helps to reduce range anxiety among the users.
- Design and development of a gasifier to produce syngas from plastic waste at homes and using the gas to run a generator to produce electricity.
- Design and development of a paddy grain transportation system





to transfer harvested paddy from the field to the trucks or other means of transportation located on the road.

- CIDRIE and MITS are also engaged with the One District One Idea (ODOI) K-DISC (Kerala Development and Innovation Strategy Council) project to develop the handicrafts cluster at Pampakuda.
- CIDRIE also has started an upskilling program through the offer of on the job internships. CIDRIE Summer Internships for students, Project Associateship for non-teaching staff and Project Leadership for faculty has been started and is successfully progressing. The stakeholders get to work on live industrial projects that CIDIRIE is involved with thereby gaining knowledge and skill in solution generation, design and implementation.




